# Part Thirty-Five: The Beginning of the Two Seeds (cont.)

Text: Gen. 4:5b-15

- Nine characteristics of a person whose heart is not right with God:
- II. THE WICKEDNESS OF THE SERPENT'S SEED
  - 1. He got when he didn't get his way (vs. 5b-6).
    - "Very wroth" = Cain was burning with .
    - "Countenance fell" = he couldn't look God in the eye.
  - 2. He served (vs. 7).
    - "Desire" = same word used for the powerful desire of a woman for husband, even a \_\_\_\_\_ (Gen. 3:16).
    - "Lie" = to \_\_\_\_\_, like a lion ready to pounce on its prey.
  - 3. He refused God's second and third chances for

\_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 6. 9).

- God spoke to Cain twice to help him to make the decision to do 0 \_\_\_\_\_, but he turned a deaf ear to God.
- He \_\_\_\_\_ his righteous brother (vs. 8). 4.
  - The reason Cain picked a fight with Abel was because he resented 0 the fact that his brother was doing right when he was doing \_\_\_\_\_ (1 John 3:12).

5. He \_\_\_\_\_ out of the hatred in his heart (vs. 8, 10).

- And became the first person to shed the \_\_\_\_\_ of another human being.
- God's response (vs. 10): 0
  - An response (sin breaks God's heart).
  - An \_\_\_\_\_ response (sin invites God's iustice).
- Application: Do you hate anyone? Hatred is incipient 0 in the heart (1 John 3:15).
- He \_\_\_\_\_ about his sin (vs. 9). 6.
  - "I not" = a lie. 0
  - Lying is second nature to the seed of the serpent (Ps. 58:3-4) and 0 also invites God's judgment (Rev. 21:8).
- 7. He tried to avoid personal \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 9).
  - "Am I my brother's \_\_\_\_\_?" Right answer = yes.
  - As God held Cain responsible, He will also hold us accountable for 0 how our \_\_\_\_\_\_ impact people around us (Prov. 24:11-12, Rom. 14:11-12).

# 8. He was \_\_\_\_\_\_ because of his sin (vs. 11-12).

• Because Abel's blood had been soaked up by the \_\_\_\_\_, it would no longer work for Cain.

9. He wasn't for his sin but only about the consequences (vs. 13-15).

- He didn't express repentance but only remorse:
  - Repent = to be sorry for your sin so that you turn to God as the \_\_\_\_\_ for your sin problem.
  - Remorse = to be sorry you got or that you will have to \_\_\_\_\_\_ because of your sin.

### **APPLICATIONS**

- What does it mean for us? Three right responses.
  - 1. We should consider our spiritual before God.
  - 2. We should look for any of the \_\_\_\_\_ characteristics of Cain showing out in our lives.
  - 3. We should allow our new nature to be revealed by deeds of , not hate; and , not

#### wickedness.
