Part Forty-Three: The Beginning of the Flood
Text: Gen. 7

- Four truths about the Flood:
I. The $\qquad$ fROM THE FLOOD (vs. 1-9)
- An Ark "FAQ" sheet:

1. Who was on the Ark?

- $\qquad$ and all his house

2. How did they $\qquad$ to be on the Ark?

- They were "seen $\qquad$ " by God.

3. Who was not on the Ark?

- The rest of Noah's $\qquad$ .

4. What else was taken into the Ark?

○ $\qquad$ pairs of every kind of clean animal
$\qquad$ pair of all other kinds of creatures

- 7 pairs of every kind of bird

5. How would there have been sufficient $\qquad$ in the Ark for all these animals?

- Every " $\qquad$ " was taken, not every "species."

6. How did all the animals get onto the Ark?

- They "went in" to Noah = God $\qquad$ them.

7. Why were Noah's family and the animals on the Ark?

- To $\qquad$ the earth after the Flood.

8. How long did other people have to come into the Ark?

- Final notice of $\qquad$ days

9. How were Noah's family and the animals $\qquad$ on the Ark?

- God" $\qquad$ them in."

10. How long were they on the Ark?
II. THE $\qquad$ of the Flood (vs. 10-13, 24)
11. The year of the Flood.

- On the 17th day of the 2nd month of Noah's $\qquad$ year.
- Probably about $\qquad$ years after God first spoke to Noah (5:32).
- 1,656 years after $\qquad$ .

2. The $\qquad$ of the Flood.

- Rising phase = $\qquad$ days (vs. 24)
- Receding phase = 221 days
- Total length from first rain until dry ground = days (8:14).

3. Three important $\qquad$ at the beginning of the Flood.

- Seven days before—Noah's family and animals $\qquad$ moving into the Ark (vs. 12).
- The day of—boarding is complete (vs. 13).
- First $\qquad$ days—rain day and night (vs. 12).
III. The Description of the Flood (vs. 11-20)

1. The $\qquad$ of the floodwaters

- The fountains of the $\qquad$
- The windows of heaven

2. The $\qquad$ of the floodwaters

- 15 cubits (approx. 25 feet) above the tops of the highest
IV. The $\qquad$ OF THE FLOOD (vs. 21-23)
- The $\qquad$ of all land-dwelling creatures living on the surface of the earth.
- Question: "If God is $\qquad$ why did He kill all those people?"
