•	God's Word (Gen. 3:1)
0	"Yea, hath God said?"
0	"Hath God said it to?"
 Outright 	(Gen. 3:4-5)
0	He will directly God.
0	He will mix some with his lie to make the lie more appealing.
•	(Eph. 6:16; 2 Tim. 1:7-8, 4:16-17; 1 Pet. 5:8)
0	Eph. 6:16: His fiery darts can include fears.
0	1 Tim. 1:7-8: He will do all he can to scare us out of our faith, frighten us out of serving God, or make us timid or
0	1 Pet. 5:8: He will try to intimidate us by his
•	(2 Cor. 2:7, 11)
0	He will try to "swallow us up" with "overmuch"
•	driving between believers (2 Cor. 2:8-11)
0	He will exploit any lack of forgiveness or full reconciliation by trying to drive a wedge between believers.
•	(Job 2:9-10)
0	Doubt spirals downward to discouragement and then to despair, which is a deep pit of much sorrow mixed with much
0	In trials, Satan may try to get us to give in to despair as he tried to do with Job through his despairing
0	Important application: We must be extremely careful what we say to people when we are living in If we allow the devil to use our mind for a playground, we may become his instrument for taking someone else down (Matt. 16:22-23).

•	Guilt and	(Job 4:12-21)
	0	Satan may suggest untrue thoughts to our minds or attempt to amplify guilt (as he did with Eliphaz) by telling us that:
		■ "God isn't" (vs. 18).
		"You're too big a for God to help you" (vs. 17, 19).
		"God doesn't" (vs. 19-20).
	0	Insight 1: Satan may try to use guilt to compound our doubts.
	0	Insight 2: Just a little suggestion can go a long way. Satan will start with any suggestion that works (against ourselves or others), but ultimately, he will accuse of being unfair.
	0	Insight 3: Satan probably can't read our thoughts, but he can whisper suggestions to our without words.
