## **Understanding Our Victory**

## **16. What are the means of victory over Satan in trials?**

- "Active \_\_\_\_\_\_ on the ground of the cross" (1 Pet. 5:8-9)
- Putting on the whole \_\_\_\_\_ of God (Eph. 6:13-17)
- \_\_\_\_\_ and supplication (Eph. 6:18-20)
- \_\_\_\_\_ in God Who raises the dead (2 Cor. 1:8-10)
- The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the saints (2 Cor. 1:11)
  - When going through difficult trials and tests, it's not enough to be praying for ourselves; we must have \_\_\_\_\_ praying for us (Gal. 6:2).
  - The Corinthian believers were Paul's "\_\_\_\_\_\_ together" in prayer, and the gift of deliverance he received was bestowed "by \_\_\_\_\_\_ persons."
  - <u>Application</u>: Don't underestimate the power and importance of the prayers of other saints to win the victory over the trial you face.

## • The high \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God (Psalm 149:5-9)

- One of the most effective ways to wield the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Word of God against the enemy is to praise God!
- "High praises" = probably using the \_\_\_\_\_\_ itself to praise the Lord.
