- Text: John 1:19-37; focus on vs. 29.

I. THE _____ OF THE LAMB

- (Vs. 29) Jesus (His _____; cousin of John);
- (Vs. 34) The Son of God (His _____; revealed by the Spirit).
- Together = both God and man; the God-man; also the Messiah.
- The Lamb of God:
 - “The” = the one and _____;
 - “Of God” = in every way = the Lamb acceptable to God, belonging to God, _____ from God, and given by God for a very special purpose;
 - “Lamb” = God’s own spotless, sinless _____ for the sins of the human race.

II. THE _____ OF THE LAMB

- To take away the sin of the world:
 - Not the sin of the _____ (but Gentiles too);
 - Not the sin of the _____ or elect (but of the whole world);
- Sin (singular) = the entire _____ of sins of the human race!
 - Isaiah 53:6-7: God laid on the Lamb of God the iniquity (sing.) of “us all” (the “all we” who have gone astray).
 - The Lamb of God is able to bear away the sin of the world because he _____ it all upon the cross.

- This means:
 - Not that every person will be saved, but that every person _____ be saved.
 - The sacrificial death of the Lamb of God was sufficient to pay for the sins of the entire human race, but it is efficacious (takes _____) only for those who believe.
 - He is the potential Savior of every person, but He is the _____ Savior of those who receive Him as such (1 Tim. 4:10; John 3:16).
 - God loves all people, and all people have a Savior because Jesus died for all, but if you want to be saved, you must _____.
