## BEHOLD THE LAMB OF GOD! Sunday AM, March 6, 2022

- <u>Text</u>: John 1:19-37; focus on vs. 29.
- I. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF THE LAMB
- (Vs. 29) Jesus (His \_\_\_\_\_; cousin of John);
- (Vs. 34) The Son of God (His \_\_\_\_\_; revealed by the Spirit).
- Together = both God and man; the God-man; also the Messiah.
- The Lamb of God:
  - "The" = the one and \_\_\_\_\_;
  - "Of God" = in every way = the Lamb acceptable to God, belonging to God, \_\_\_\_\_\_ from God, and given by God for a very special purpose;
  - "Lamb" = God's own spotless, sinless
    \_\_\_\_\_ for the sins of the human race.

## II. THE \_\_\_\_\_\_ OF THE LAMB

- To take away the sin of the world:
  - $\circ$  Not the sin of the \_\_\_\_\_ (but Gentiles too);
  - Not the sin of the \_\_\_\_\_ or elect (but of the whole world);
- Sin (singular) = the entire \_\_\_\_\_\_ of sins of the human race!
  - Isaiah 53:6-7: God laid on the Lamb of God the iniquity (sing.) of "us all" (the "all we" who have gone astray).
  - The Lamb of God is able to bear away the sin of the world because he \_\_\_\_\_\_ it all upon the cross.

- This means:
  - Not that every person <u>will</u> be saved, but that every person \_\_\_\_\_ be saved.
  - The sacrificial death of the Lamb of God was sufficient to pay for the sins of the entire human race, but it is efficacious (takes \_\_\_\_\_) only for those who believe.
  - He is the potential Savior of every person, but He is the Savior of those who receive Him as such (1 Tim. 4:10; John 3:16).
  - God loves all people, and all people have a Savior because Jesus died for all, but if you want to be saved, you must \_\_\_\_\_.

## III. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF THE LAMB

- Since these things about Lamb of God are true, we need to "\_\_\_\_\_\_" Him with eyes of understanding and faith.
- <u>Question</u>: Have you believed (been born again; vs. 10-13)?
- IV. THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF THE LAMB
- As believers, we should never \_\_\_\_\_ beholding the Lamb of God!
  - The best way to keep on beholding our Lord and Savior is to \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him wherever He goes (vs. 35-37; Rev. 14:4).
- Question: Are you \_\_\_\_\_\_ following the Lamb of God?
- If we know that all our sins have been \_\_\_\_\_ out of the way, the only right way to live is "unto Him Who died for us and rose again."
