I.	THE TO FAITH (VS. 22-24)
A.	The Problem of the Disciples
•	Their boat was opposed by and afflicted by waves.
B.	The Purpose of the Master
•	Vs. 22, Jesus "constrained" His disciples = He them go.
•	Vs. 23-24, Jesus stayed behind, also on purpose.
•	Jesus had some specific teaching objectives in mind:
	<ul> <li>He wanted them to understand that He is the</li> <li> of God.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>He also wanted to develop their in Him as God.</li> </ul>
•	Jesus had revealed Himself as the Maker of the universe when He fed the 5,000; now He would reveal Himself as the of the universe.
II.	THE TO FAITH (Vs. 25-29)
A.	The Proclamation of God
•	"It is I" = <u>ego eimi</u> = "I," the divine name of Jehovah God (John 8:58).
B.	The Proposal of Peter
•	"Lord, since it's you, me to come to you on the water!"
•	His request was ambitious, but it glorified God.
C.	The Permission of Jesus
•	Vs. 29, "Come!"

•	<u>Application 1</u> : God sends trials so we can know Him better by personally His promises and faithfulness.

III.	THE OF FAITH (vs. 30-33)

A.	The for Stepping out by Faith
•	Vs. 30, Peter "saw the wind boisterous, and began to fear."
	<ul> <li>He took his eyes off to look at the winds and waves.</li> </ul>
•	Application: If you start looking at the waves, you're going to be afraid, just ike Peter (Philip. 4:13, 2 Cor. 12:9, Ps. 94:17-18).
В.	The That Inhibits Stepping out by Faith
•	The fear of is why many of us will never dare to step out of the boat in the first place to attempt new and bigger things for God.
•	But if God calls us to get out of the boat, He'll keep us If He says, "Come," He will enable us to come.
C.	The That Upholds our Steps of Faith
•	Vs. 30, " to sink" = Peter either sank slowly or only part-way.
	<ul> <li>Peter panicked because his perspective was, "I'm sinking"; but the reality of physics was that the Lord was still</li></ul>
•	Application: The Lord Jesus will never let you go!
	<ul> <li>In hand of Jesus, you as a child of God will always stand far</li> <li>the misery and hopelessness of a world that is lost and far from God (Ps. 18:32-33).</li> </ul>
•	Vs. 31: Jesus grabbed Peter in a mighty grip and rebuked him, not sternly but: "Little faith, why did you doubt?"
	<ul> <li>The purpose of this learning experience was to train Peter's faith and teach him to keep His on the Lord even in the midst of the winds and waves.</li> </ul>
•	A life of faith is a life of to Jesus, whether the water s calm or winds are blowing strong.
	<ul> <li>A. W. Tozer defines faith as "the continuous</li> <li> of the soul upon a saving God."</li> </ul>
