	 "Spoiling (robbing, plundering) of their goods" = their possessions had been confiscated by their enemies because of their testimony, yet they had responded with a attitude. 			
	They had demonstrated for the brethren.			
	"Companions" (vs. 33) = they came alongside those suffering and ministered to their needs.			
	"Had compassion" (vs. 34) = they had for the author in prison and had done what they could to help him in that trial.
